Grain Offering	No independent purpose	Brought in conjunction with other sacrifices	<i>Contributed to the completion of the primary sacrifice.</i>
Peace Offering	1.THANKSGIVING 2.FUFILL A VOW 3.FREEWILL OFFERING	1._SOME OF ANIMAL BURNED. 2.the Rest EATEN AS A SPECIAL MEAL.	JOY AND CELEBRATION
Sin Offering  -----  Guilt Offering	<b>Atonement</b>  1. Restrains or calms anger. 2. Cleanses or removes an offense. 3. Forgiveness of the sinner. 4. Consecrate to an especially holy status.	<b>Before the Sacrifice...</b> 1. The person must realize their offense.. 2. The person must <u>Recognize their guilt.</u> 3. The person must Confess their sin.. 4. The person must make restitution.  <b>The Sacrifice...</b> 1. The person kills the animal. 2. The priest manipulates the blood.	<b>The Heart and Forgiveness</b>  Israel's atonement was by God's grace. and only by God's grace!  <b>But...</b> Salvation by grace does not set human responsibility aside
